Chapter 1: The Foundation of Reverence

Pillar 1 — Fear of the LORD × Wisdom

“The fear of the LORD is the instruction for wisdom, and before honor comes humility.”
(Proverbs 15:33)

*“This is what the Spirit of the Fear of the LORD, when passed through Wisdom, produces as a pillar. Not a posture you visit—
but a foundation you stand on.”*
